BOOT CAMP OFFERINGS: ADULT DIVISION

(Adults will remain in class from 9:15 a.m. – 12:00 p.m.)

The Boot Camp Program was initiated as a Four-Year Christian Development Program for Youth and their Adult Leaders. The program consisted of four strands identified as Camps with a different focus area of enrichment. We have completed the four-year cycle that was originally plan. The response to the initiative has been overwhelming.

We are now in Phase II of the Boot Camp Program which will provide a more intense program designed to assist youth and leaders in addressing issues that are currently impacting the lives of young people in our local church. In Phase II of the Boot Camp Program, we will provide two of the original Camp Workshops at each Boot Camp because we have new leaders attending each year that can benefit from the basic foundation provided by the original Camp Workshop. We will add two or more additional workshops each year to address those issues that we must deal with in our local churches when working in youth ministry.

Completion Certificates: Each person that has attended all four sessions is eligible to receive a Christian Education Certificate from the Young People's Department. One of the new workshops can replace Camp Delta if needed. An Advanced Certificate will be awarded when four (4) additional workshops are completed. The Boot Camp Four Year Training Program Course Documentation Card is included in this packet and should be turned in by May 1, 2018 for this year's recognition. The cards must be signed by your local Pastor. If you are unsure of your courses, we will provide another form at Boot Camp for requesting assistance. Persons who complete the program will receive the certificate and be printed in the Annual State Convention Program in July 2018.

DESCRIPTION OF CHILDREN AND YOUTH SESSIONS

Children’s Division Level 1: Ages 6-8 Level 2: Ages 9-11

The Children’s Division will focus on two key areas:

1. **What is Prayer?** *The goal of this presentation is to assist children in understanding what prayer is, where prayer came from, and why it is important.*
2. **How Do You Pray?** *This session will help children to understand how to pray at their maturity level.*

Track II Young, Black, Male, and Saved (Young Men Ages 12 – 18 or Still in High School)

Track III Young, Black, Female, and Saved (Young Ladies Ages 12 – 18 or Still in High School)

The youth in these two tracks will participate in a general session on the theme, participate in focus groups, attend regional meetings, and participate in the regional and state election process.

YOUTH SUMMIT DIVISION

State and Regional Officers are elected every two years and 2018 is an election year. Our objectives for this year at the youth summit are:

1. To praise God and learn more about spiritual warfare.

2. To elect regional and state officers.
3. To provide youth with an opportunity to evaluate the programs that we have implemented during the past three years while addressing some critical needs of our young people.
4. To showcase ministry talent from around the state.
5. To share information about State Rally Day 2018, State Convention 2018, and other upcoming events.

Honors and Graduate Recognition Program

The Young People's Department recognizes high school and college graduates from all areas of the state each year. Graduates participate in an opening procession and are recognized on the **Tuesday of the State Convention each year** along with the district honorees. **Every church** that has a graduating high school senior or college student can have that person recognized in the Honor and Graduate Recognition Program. They do not have to be present to receive their gift and certificate and be recognized in the Souvenir Program. Wedding of the Roses Pageant



The Wedding of the Roses Pageant is held each year during the State Convention. Each district is asked to have at least one participant in the Rose Queen Category and possibly participants in the other categories listed below:

1. Rose Queen for Young Ladies ages 12 to 17
2. Little Miss Rose Bud or Master Rose Bud for Young Ladies and Men Ages 5 - 9
3. Lil Angels for Boys and Girls Ages 0-4

The following guidelines will be adhered to:

- A girl and boy pageant winner will be recognized in each category.
- Trophies and Certificates of Participation will be awarded to each participant in the pageant. The girl and boy winners of the pageant will be presented with a crown and a scepter which will be the property of the Young People's Department and will be used by winners for the following years. The Rose Queen receives a monetary incentive.
- Dress Attire for all contestants is as follows:
 - Girls: White or pastel colored dresses of their choice. Rose contestants **MUST** wear white cotillion style dresses.
 - Boys: Dark Suits with white shirts and tie or bowtie.
- Participants will participate in the procession on Tuesday Night during the Director's Hour.

Regional and State Officer Application



General Requirements for State and Regional Officer Candidates

- ✓ Must be a member of a church that is a member of the Louisiana Missionary Baptist Convention.
- ✓ Must be between the ages of 12 and 22 years of age.
- ✓ Must be active in their local church and district association.
- ✓ Must have the appropriate level of maturity, Christian Character, and leadership skills that will enable them to fulfill their obligations.
- ✓ Must be able to attend district, regional, and state meetings.
- ✓ Must have the approval and verification of their Youth Director, Pastor, and District Director.
- ✓ Must be present during the elections which will be held during the January 2018 Boot Camp.

Additional Criteria for State Officer Positions

- ✓ Must have attended a regional meeting during the previous year and a state convention within the last two years.
- ✓ Must be able to attend the regional meetings in their area and the state convention.
- ✓ Must have attended the Youth Summit from the previous year.

Special Note

- ✓ Youth Officers who were elected previously and did not attend regional and state meetings following their election are ineligible to run for a position this year.
- ✓ The State Director will fill all positions vacant after the Youth Summit with the assistance of Regional and District Directors.
- ✓ Each church will be represented by two voting delegates.
- ✓ Former Officers are welcome to run again for positions.
